was reminded how lucky I was when they brought a 71 year old man to the hospital when I was there. He died 5 minutes after his arrival. He was the loser in an accident where a person not paying attention made a left turn right in front of him while he rode his motorcycle. The lesson is that life is a gift and can be taken away quickly at no fault of your own. I feel lucky to have walked away with a few bruises of mind and body, but my faith is still well founded and strengthened by the experience.

We had a singing group who used our parking lot and water to do golf cart and car washes. In other words our mission as the Masons of Winter Garden is right on track and moving along well.
