

Fraternal Greeting My Brothers:

I want to say that it was an honor being asked to add something new to our Masonic Trestle Board from the Past Masters Corner. I am a life long resident of Winter Garden. My father was a member in good standing in our Lodge. My uncle, Buddy Donahey, is also a Past Master of Winter Garden Lodge, so I did have a connection to Freemasonry even though back in those days, very little was spoken.

I was raised a Master Mason on August 1, 2009 at an Outdoor Degree held at W:. Gary Story's previous home here in Winter Garden, an event I will never forget. I joined Freemasonry for the fellowship, nothing more. I wasn't interested in the "Secrets" or ritual work, but I was looking for friendship. All <u>my</u> friends from school, I lost touch with or they moved away, leaving me to hang out with husbands and friends of my wife. Actually, she was the one that suggested I petition


Greetings from Orange Assembly #134's Worthy Advisor Shelby!
