

Becoming a Master Mason

Petitions Process & Fees



The Process

After careful consideration by a man to join our Fraternity, he should complete a Petition for the Degrees of Freemasonry, which must be signed by two Brothers of the Lodge and submitted, along with a Applicant Background Waiver and the appropriate fees.

Two Committees of Brothers, typically three each, meet with the Applicant to discuss the process, answer questions, and inquire into the background and character of the Applicant. A Criminal Background Check is performed by a third party company, contracted by the Grand Lodge of Florida.

After investigations and inquiries, the Lodge Ballots on an application (petition). Note that it typically takes 6-8 weeks for this to occur, depending upon meeting dates and availability of the applicant to meet with the committees.

If the applicant is approved by the Brothers of the Lodge, he will be notified and a date set for conferring the First Symbolic Degree of Masonry. After this degree, the new Brother must learn certain things and prove to the lodge his proficiency before he can progress to the next degree.

After proving his proficiency in the First Degree, a date is set for the conferring of the Second Degree, and follows the same path of learning and proving proficiency before the This Degree is conferred.



Application

- Submit Application Forms:
 - Petition for Degrees
 - ♦ Applicant Background Waiver
 - ♦ Background & Degree Fees
- Background Check is Performed (by an independent 3rd party company)
- Petitions Committee Reviews Forms
- They will meet with the applicant to ensure the forms are correct and complete.
- Petition is read in Lodge and Published in Lodge Trestleboard
- Investigations Committee Meets with Applicant (This usually occurs at the applicants residence)
- Lodge Ballots on Application (at least one month after Petition is Read)

Degrees

- First Degree is Conferred at a Meeting
 - ♦ Brother learns the "work"
 - Brother demonstrates Proficiency
- Second Degree is Conferred at a Meeting
 - ♦ Brother learns the "work"
 - ♦ Brother demonstrates Proficiency
- Third Degree is Conferred at a Meeting
 - ♦ Brother learns the "work"
 - O Brother demonstrates Proficiency
- Applicant is now a Master Mason
